Six Mile Creek Bridge inspection

Six Mile Creek Bridge on the Bruce Highway will be reduced to a single lane on Thursday 20 February between 8pm and 5am for a routine inspection, weather permitting.

Transport and Main Roads Director-General Neil Scales said the inspection had been scheduled outside peak periods to minimise community impacts.

"Variable message signs have been put in place advising motorists of the upcoming bridge works," Mr Scales said.

"Traffic controllers will also be in place to assist with the changed traffic conditions."

Mr Scales thanked the local Gympie community for its understanding and cooperation while the inspection was completed.

"We understand the inconvenience these works have on the community and will complete the inspections as quickly as possible," he said.
