1. Student eligibility requirements

To be eligible for a Tertiary Transport Card a student must be:

- a full-time* student attending an educational institution/s in Queensland; and
- undertaking a course approved by Centrelink for Austudy, Abstudy or Youth Allowance purposes, or at the post-graduate level.

* For Queensland Transport purposes, a full-time student is deemed a student that must actually attend an educational institution/s for a minimum of 12 hours per week for the duration of the course. The course duration must be a minimum period of three months or 12 weeks.
